

50/50 Draw

ELIGIBILITY

- Participation is reserved exclusively for people aged 18 and over
- The following individuals are not eligible to participate in the half-and-half draws: current volunteers and employees of the 50/50 draw, employees of the Fondation and members of their immediate family, employees of the company providing the technology for the draw and members of the Board of Directors of the Fondation

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- The participant will receive a printed coupon listing the numbers associated with the purchase of his/her ticket. The ticket numbers corresponding to the purchase are instantly printed in a barrel, in a secure location
- Tickets are sold in packages of 2 for \$10; 10 for \$20; 40 for \$50 or 100 for \$100
- Tickets sales will only take place during the Formula 1 Grand Prix du Canada at the Circuit Gilles-Villeneuve in Montréal
- Three independent draws are scheduled at this location:
 - Friday, June 7th at 3:30 pm
 - Saturday, June 8th at 3:30 pm
 - Sunday, June 9th at 1 pm
- Ticket sales begin after the opening to the public of the Grand Prix du Canada and will end 30 minutes before the time indicated on the ticket. The sellers are located in three locations, two clearly identified “Fondation Bon départ” locations on the site of the event, and in the suites. The sellers are easily identifiable
- Ticket purchase is final and non-refundable

DRAW AND COMMUNICATION WITH THE WINNER

- Chances of winning depend on the total number of tickets sold
- Tickets are subject to verification by the half-and-half organizers. Any fraudulent ticket will automatically be rejected and will not be eligible for a prize
- An independent party will proceed to a random draw among all the tickets purchased until the end of the sale, under the supervision of an accounting firm
- After verification of eligibility, the winning number will be announced and posted on the scoreboard. If the winner left a phone number, the organizers of the draw will communicate with him/her immediately. In the event that the announced (posted) number and the official winning number not be identical, the latter will prevail
- The amount of the prize to be won (prize to the winner) represents 50% of the total amount raised and announced (jackpot)
- In the event that the amount announced (posted) and the amount raised not be identical, the latter will prevail
- In the event that the person whose ticket is selected does not claim his/her prize within the 15-minute delay mandated by the Régie des alcools, des courses et des jeux (RACJ), a second number will be drawn and will be posted on the scoreboard
- The winning number and the amount will also be available at the ticket sale locations and with sellers
- The holder of the winning ticket must present himself/herself to one of the sales locations in order to claim his/her prize in the 15 minutes following the posting of the winning number (as per RACJ regulations). The Fondation Bon départ de Canadian Tire du Québec assumes no responsibility towards any person declaring an interest or right to receive all or part of the prize associated with the winning ticket
- The prize will be issued via cheque and mailed within 60 business days of the prize being claimed by the winner
- The winning person must complete a Declaration and liability release form before taking possession of the prize

OTHER GENERAL CONDITIONS

- If the electronic system experiences major technical difficulties (i.e., at any moment following the start of the sale of tickets using the system), the sales of the half-and-half will immediately be suspended for the rest of the day. If the Fondation Bon départ de Canadian Tire du Québec is able to verify that all tickets purchased prior to the suspension of the sale were correctly stored, the draw will take place and a winner will be announced as planned. If the Fondation Bon départ de Canadian Tire du Québec is not able to verify that all tickets purchased prior to the suspension of the sale were correctly stored, the draw will be postponed until the Fondation Bon départ de Canadian Tire du Québec is able to perform this verification. If a draw has been postponed, the Fondation Bon départ de Canadian Tire du Québec will announce the winner as soon as possible and will post the winning number as indicated above
- The Fondation Bon départ de Canadian Tire du Québec and all sponsors and partners of this half-and-half program administer it in good faith and in the greater interest of the Fondation. No partner (nor employee or representative of any one of them) is liable at any time for any error, malfunction of the system or decisions made related to the management of the program
